PÄRNU IS EASY TO REACH!

Pärnu is easy to find and even easier to reach! On the European map, Pärnu is located in north-eastern Europe just where the Baltic Sea joins Latvia, Estonia, Finland and Sweden together. The city lies between Rīga, Helsinki and Stockholm. The easiest way to get here is to book an international flight to the Estonian capital Tallinn or the Latvian capital Rīga. Pärnu is only a couple of hours away from either airport by car.

RANNAHOTELL

At 6.00 pm on 17 July 1937, one of the most luxurious hotels of its era – not only in Estonia but in Northern Europe as a whole – began welcoming guests: Pärnu Rannahotell. Constructed to the designs of architects O. Siinmaa and A. Soans, the hotel was state-of-the-art at the time and even today is considered one of the 10 true architectural masterpieces of Estonia. At the time of its opening, the hotel had 70 rooms with 102 beds and 35 sofas, including six double apartments and one triple apartment.

The interior of Rannahotell was last renovated in 2016. It now has 55 rooms, 11 of which are spacious suites. There is a large saloon and restaurant with sea views on the first floor.

Designed by Finnish architect Kosti Kuronen, this 18-hole championship course is the first of its kind in Pärnu County. The 84-hectare area features large greens, broad fairways and 19 hectares of water hazards.

The links-type course close to the sea is open to the winds, providing a challenge for both beginners and advanced players. The

soft winter climate in Estonia's coastal areas does not drain the grass, meaning that by early spring the course is in excellent condition, allowing you to begin the season in March. Our soft fairways and even surfaces make the course suitable for senior players as well. The clubhouse is open to all visitors and the restaurant is well known for its excellent food.

TASTE AUTHENTIC ESTONIAN FOOD

Traditional food has always been valued in Pärnu County. That is why you'll find real local dishes on the menus of cafés and restaurants. Sometimes they are prepared on old-fashioned wood-burning stoves; hand-picked berries and mushrooms are used as ingredients. Fish is often caught in Pärnu Bay the same morning. In addition to restaurants, you'll find the foods of local producers at the Farmers' Market at Pärnu Keskus shopping centre. Special aroma and taste experiences are offered by the Tamme Farm herb garden and store just outside Pärnu.

Real connoisseurs can follow the 250-km Romantic Coastline itinerary along Pärnu Bay, which connects food to culture, nature and history. While travelling along the Romantic Coastline, you'll get to know the traditional ways of the coastal people, experience some unique culture and refuel yourself with locally produced food.

KIHNU

THE MOST EXOTIC ISLAND IN ESTONIA, UNIQUE IN THE WORLD

Kihnu, a former island of seal hunters and fishing folk, is culturally unique in the world and is definitely the most exotic place in Estonia. This is why Kihnu's cultural heritage is on the UNESCO list of intangible heritage.

The island and its ca 600 inhabitants showcase a strong community and old traditions; the Kihnu language, singing, dancing and instrumental music are integral parts of life. Over the centuries, the men of Kihnu have spent a large chunk of their life at sea, leaving island matters to the women folk. Women have become the keepers and bearers of traditional handicrafts, dances, games and music. Even today you might see

them riding motor bikes in their striped Kihnu skirts. Kihnu is a magnificent place for a day trip and it is great to explore the island on a bike. You can rent one on the island.

Culture lovers will appreciate the home visits, truck rides and fishing trips. In summer, you can enjoy a beautiful view of the whole island, the surrounding islets and the sea from the top of the lighthouse. Kihnu Museum, which welcomes visitors year-round, provides an overview of the history of the island, including the life of famous local captain Kihnu Jõnn.

Soomaa National Park is an area in Pärnu and Viljandi counties with lots of bogs and marshes. Altogether there are five bogs in Soomaa, which is dubbed the 'capital of the Estonian wilderness'. On the banks of winding rivers, diverse water and wooded

meadows have developed as a result of traditional land use. Visitors can enjoy hiking and canoe and bog-shoe tours and even observe beavers.

Soomaa is a place with five seasons: spring, summer, autumn, winter and the floods. Visitors are mostly familiar with the floods known as the fifth season: When the snow melts and heavy rain hits the area, low forested areas, roads and even yards are flooded. During this period, water enthusiasts can row on the rivers and sometimes even canoe in the forests.

ESCAPING FROM THE FORMER PÄRNU PRISON

The largest complex of escape rooms full of different puzzles anywhere in Northern and Eastern Europe is right here. The prison you have to escape from hides the secrets of the most psychopathic criminals.

You have to escape from the prison in three hours. If you get stuck, you can ask the prison guards for clues – for a decent bribe.
