
## PARKING IN PÄRNU TOWN OFFICIAL AREAS

Parking tickets can be bought from the bus station R-Kiosk (Pikk 13), Pärnu City Government (Suur-Sepa 16) and Pärnu Beach Stadium (Ranna pst 2).

Tickets issued from the parking meter: the calculation of the parking fee is minute-based, the free parking time is automatically added to the end time of the ticket.

- First 60 minutes and on Sundays free of charge.
- SMS parking: PKESKLINN, PKESKLINN60\*

(including national and public holidays) 1 hour = 5 €

24 hours = 25 €

- First 30 minutes free of charge
- SMS parking: PRAND, PRAND30\*
- The ticket is also valid for the same period in the Old Town and City Centre area

• First 60 minutes and on Sundays free of charge.

Parking is free for the first 3 hours on the central square parking lot in front of the Endla theatre.

- SMS parking: PVANALINN, **PVANALINN60\***
- The ticket is also valid in the City Centre area

## SMS parking (SMS

(Only for Estonian mobile operator customers)

- To start parking, send a SMS to number 1902. Write: license plate number, space, area designation (e.g.: 123ABC PVANALINN)\*
- \* To use the free parking time, add free minutes provided for the area (e.g.: 123ABC PVANALINN60)
- To **stop** parking, call 1903
  - Parking fee is calculated on a per-minute basis.
  - After five hours of parking, the 24-hour parking fee valid in the area will be charged (if the parking is uninterrupted).

PARGI.EE or Flowbird which supports paying for parking with a bank card and which can also be used in the absence of a contract with an Estonian mobile

operator.
